Join us on July 25 from 7:30 a.m. - 3:00 p.m. as we build our Scottie Yard Playground! We will provide snacks, drinks, lunch and music for the day. Our volunteers will be working in teams to unpack the equipment, place the equipment in the appropriate locations, use battery operated screwdrivers and other power tools to put together and secure various playground pieces. We need 50 volunteers willing to carry, lift, bend and be available for the entire day. We have lots to do and would love for our Scottie Supporters to participate in the building of the playground.
